WHAT IS FOSMAS ANYWAY, AND HOW CAN YOU HELP?

FOSMAS is a charity established for two purposes:

- To build strong relationships between staff and parents;
- To engage in activities or provide facilities or equipment which support the school and advance the education of the pupils.

We do this through organising enjoyable social events such as the International Dinner and next term's Quiz Night, and through fundraising events such as the monthly cake and uniform sales, the Blue Bag collection, the Christmas and Summer Fairs and the Fun Run. We warmly welcome creative ideas for new fundraising events!

The money we raise goes to pay for things like Science Week and Book Week events, theatre trips and new playground markings – the things that enrich our children's curriculum and school life on a day-to-day basis. We <u>don't</u> do large scale capital fundraising. That's the responsibility of the Governors. You'll be hearing more soon about their drive to raise funds for a major upgrade of the school buildings in the medium term. We've agreed to leave it to them to approach the big potential corporate sponsors for funds this year. That means that to keep funding the events your children love in the short term, we are more dependent than ever before on YOU to help make our regular fundraising events a success.

The Committee can't possibly do it all on our own. We need your help! There are about 150 families at St Mary Abbots. If every family gives just a little help, we can achieve a lot! We are very grateful for the work of your Class Reps (list on FOSMAS website), who do a great job of organising the monthly cake sales, building close links between "their" parents and pulling together volunteers for key FOSMAS events. They deserve your enthusiastic support. But we welcome individual offers of help too.
