
Every year **FOSMAS** fund raises towards much needed equipment and school activities

The above only accounts for the Teachers' Wish List! FOSMAS supports the school financially in many other ways:

- Events and school trips coaches for school trips, end-school year disco (Year 6 leavers), KS2 movie night, etc.
- Small school upgrades last year FOSMAS paid for the KS1 cloakroom refurb and replaced the projector for the school hall (worth £8,500).

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Please sign up for regular giving

Every year FOSMAS set an annual fundraising target to cover for the Teachers Wish List, small upgrades and other activities (e.g. school trips and events). This target does not include big projects mentioned before.

All funds are invested in events and facilities our children love. enriching the curriculum and school life on a day-to-day basis. So far this school year we have raised £15.2K and have given the school £17.9k towards the Teachers' Wish List. This means that, so far this year, we have spent more than what we have raised. Please consider setting up a monthly donation to FOSMAS. Currently only a few parents give to **FOSMAS** on a monthly basis. You can donate via the link on the FOSMAS website, www.fosmas.info. Simply click on the "make a monthly donation" button. If you are a UK tax payer, make sure to click the Gift Aid button so we can maximise your donation (Gift Aid adds 25% extra to your donation, which comes from taxes). You can also use the link to make a one-off payment.

PLEASE NOTE: FOSMAS IS NOT the Governors' Fund (collected via School Comms). The money **FOSMAS** collect goes to an entirely **different** fund from the Governors' Fund.
