

Inkjet recycling FOSMAS has just registered with **Empties Please**, a company who specialise in recycling used ink cartridges. Their aim is to help schools and charities raise funds and to encourage the next generation to get greener by collecting and recycling used inkjet cartridges.

Having received Mrs Doyle's permission we will place a few collection boxes at school and will also have extra bags for home or office use. They will pay us £1 for an original manufacturer cartridge except Epson or Brother, and 50p for a remanufactured cartridge. Please recycle HP, Lexmark, Dell and Canon. They will not accept ANY laser toners, inkjet only. When full we simply take the box to a local collection centre and they send us a cheque.
